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Main Assistant Coach

Primary Focus: Communication, athlete motivation, practice support, stats, and gametime decision-making support, first base director

Responsibilities

- **Drill Leadership:** Run warm-ups and skill stations alongside Head Coach
- **Motivator:** Be a consistent source of encouragement and energy during practice and games
- **Communication Liaison:**
 - Send out reminders or team info via GroupMe/Facebook
 - Filter parent questions and concerns, bringing only priority matters to Head Coach

- **Game Support:**
 - Help track in-game **stats** (hitting, fielding, pitching, etc.)
 - Assist with **lineup strategy**, substitutions, and field adjustments
- **Discipline Support:**
 - Enforce team rules respectfully
 - Address minor attitude or hustle issues as needed
- **Leadership Presence:** Model hustle, character, and attention to detail

- Approachable but firm
 - Strong communicator
 - Calm under pressure
 - Loyal to team goals, not personal agenda
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Second Assistant Coach

Primary Focus: Pitch calling, pitcher and catcher development, drill support, and athlete motivation

Responsibilities

- **Pitch Calling:**
 - Develop pitch strategies based on hitters, game flow, and scouting reports
 - Collaborate with pitchers on goals and comfort levels

- **Catcher Coach:**
 - Assist. head coach with drilling catchers on framing, blocking, footwork, throwdowns, and leadership
 - Review catcher-pitcher communication and signals
- **Drill Support:**
 - Help run position-specific drills (especially defensive and bullpen work)
 - Float between groups to offer corrections and encouragement
- **Game Engagement:**
 - Be vocal and positive in the dugout
 - Help Head Coach manage bullpen, timeouts, and defensive setups

- Detail-oriented with a sharp softball IQ
- Strong mentor energy and accountability
- Positive and proactive communicator

✚ **Shared Expectations for All Coaches**

- Always arrive **15–20 minutes early** for practices and games
- Communicate **promptly and respectfully** with Head Coach
- Reinforce team values: **effort, unity, discipline, and joy**
- Stay **solution-focused** with any challenges or concerns
- **Back each other up** in front of players and parents—speak as one unit
